Alpacas

Alpacas, domesticated in South America for several thousand years, are part of the Camelid family, related to the vicuna and guanaco – both still wild in South America.

Alpacas are shorn once a year, usually in Spring.

Neither the male ("Macho") or female ("Hembra") come into season. The female is an 'induced ovulator'.

The gestation period in 11 $\ensuremath{\sc v}_2$ months and births usually occur during daylight hours.

The female alpaca is usually re-mated about two weeks after giving birth, so it is possible for them to have one baby ("Cria") a year.

As a domestic animal, the alpaca is generally very calm and gentle and easy to manage. Halter training is easy.

For travelling purposes Alpacas can be transported easily in a horsebox or trailer.

Alpaca stocking rates, feed requirements, vaccinations and worm drenching are quite similar to sheep.

Expensive shedding is unnecessary - well placed trees for shade and shelter is often all that is required.

Alpacas are relatively rare outside South America, thus an unusual and valuable breeding animal.

Alpaca fibre is hypoallergenic and second only to silk as the strongest natural fibre in the world. It is available in 23 natural shades and colours.

Traded successfully on the world markets Alpaca fibre is internationally recognised as a versatile and durable premium fibre once reserved for Inca royalty.


